 Jean and approved by the group.
- Jane suggested that someone might like to take charge of organizing the Silent Auction and the Holiday Gift Packages. No immediate volunteers but this is something to think about.
- **Holiday packages** were set up for sale today. We are considering having a small auction on the side during the Holiday book sale, with just a few donated items including a quilt made by Kathy. Andrea is checking if the showcase is available.

- "Give My Books" came out on October 17, 2022 to collect all unsold books. They did not get to the library until 3:00 PM. We need to work out a better plan for next year.
- **Discussion**: Laurie and Jean could use some help to ensure that membership applications received during the days before the sale setup are included in the Advance Sale list.
- Jane put together a wonderful "Friends of Wixom Library Guidelines and Procedures Manual
 2022", and distributed the list of contents. There are three binders. Jane will keep the originals;

- one will be available to check out in the "Friends" Room, and Andrea will keep one as well. Still to be included is a PR Contact List.
- There is also a "History of Gifts" to the library included in the Procedures Binder. Andrea sent a thank you note to Meijer's for their donation of \$5,000 to the Children's Center. The Gifts List total now exceeds \$246,000.
